

HORSE VISION ACTIVITY

Horses see the world very differently than we do. To get an idea of how different we actually are, we are going to be using some horse vision! Depending on your resources you can either use your hand to create a blind spot OR you can print out the horse vision glasses and cut them out.

HORSE VISION USING YOUR HAND

1. When using your hand, it should be flat and fingers closed. Just like mine below!



2. Once you have a flat hand, you will place your hand over your nose with your fingers in between your eyes.

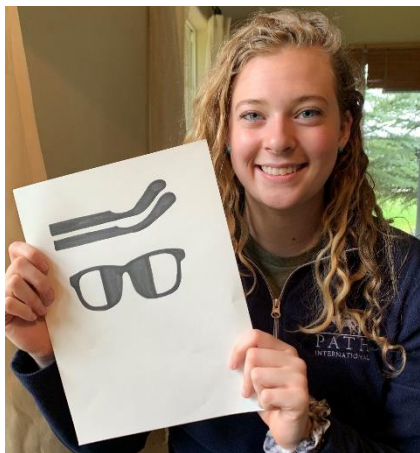


This will create a blind spot very similar to a horse!

HORSE VISION USING HORSE VISION GLASSES

You will need a pair of scissors and glue/tape.

1. Carefully cut out your horse vision glasses.



2. Once you have your horse vision glasses cut out, you will need to glue or tape on the arms.

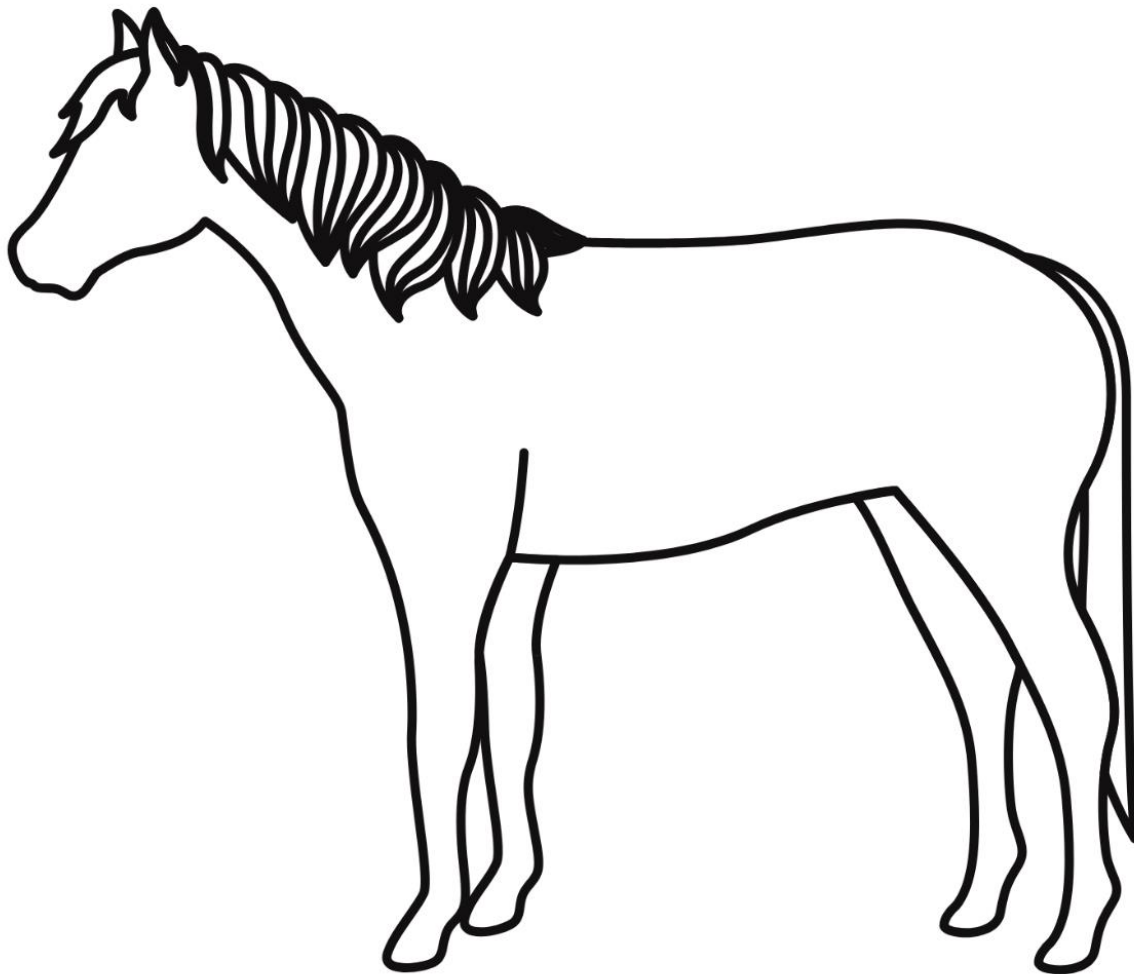


Once you have completed all of these steps, your horse vision glasses are ready!

HORSE VISION ACTIVITY

Once you have decided on which method you will use to create a blind spot you can begin the activity!

1. Before putting your horse vision glasses on, pick a colored pencil, marker or crayon and color in or trace the horse picture!
2. Now, put on your horse vision glasses and attempt to trace or color in the horse again, using a different color pencil, marker or crayon.
3. Take off your horse vision glasses and see the difference on your paper!



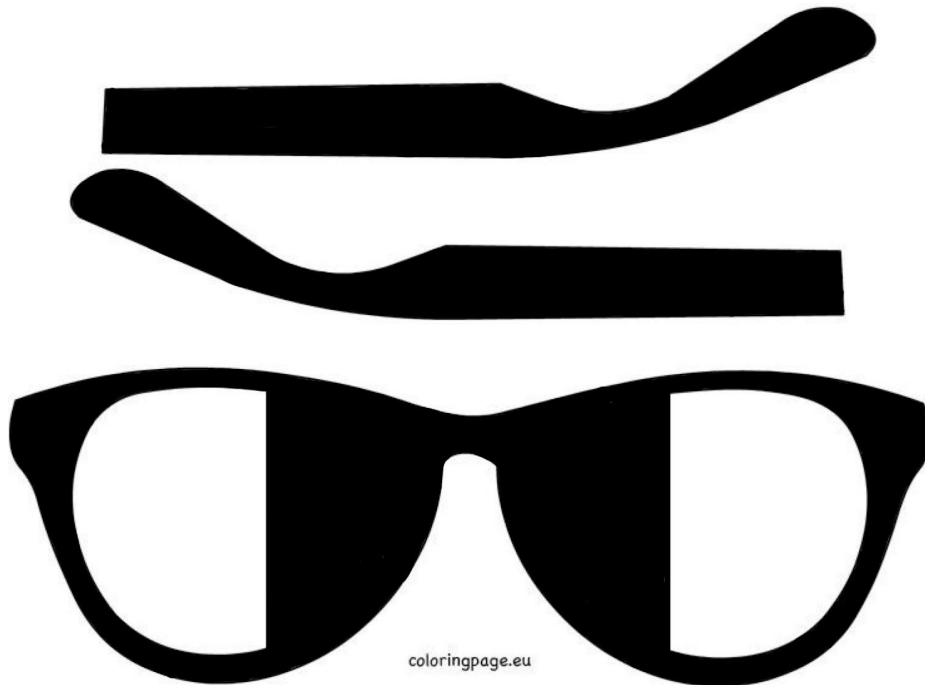
Was it more difficult with a blind spot? Did you have to turn your head to see better because of the blind spot?
