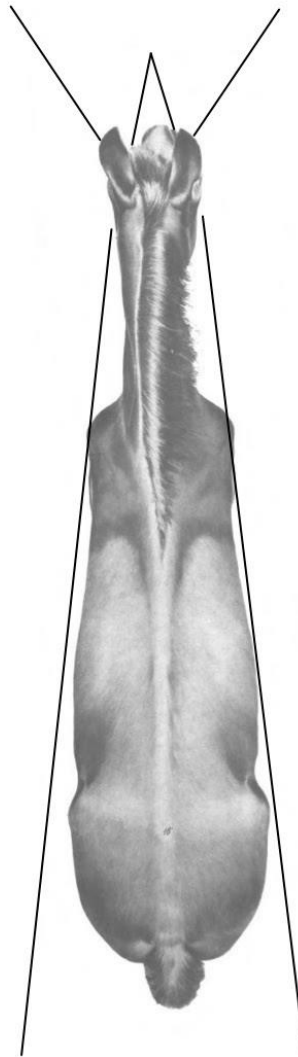


HORSE VISION QUIZ
